

Frontier Muster and Trade Faire

At The Wilderness Road Blockhouse within Natural Tunnel State Park

April 30-May 1, 2016

MANDATORY GUIDELINES

1. All participants **MUST** have firearms and ammunition inspected at The Wilderness Road Blockhouse upon arrival. Check-in will start April 29, 2016 after 10 a.m.
2. Historical Interpreters **MUST** try to be as authentic as possible. This is not a juried event.
3. Non-Authentic items must be hidden from view in historical area. (eyeglasses are the only exception)
4. No vehicles in historical area April 30th starting at 8:30 a.m. through Sunday. Vehicles may re-enter area after 3 p.m. on Sunday.
5. Those spending the night or merchants that want to spend the night in historical area must have period appropriate shelter.
6. Food in historic area must be authentic of the time period.
7. Historical Interpreters will be served breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday and breakfast and lunch Sunday. Do not forget your 18th Century period cup, mug, plate... No period eating implements no food.
8. Pets allowed, however, all pets must be restrained by a leash not exceeding 6 feet in length and under owner's control. Virginia State Law.
